Breakfast Club:

Breakfast Club will re-open starting on Monday 19th October from 8am to 8:30am. Due to COVID-19 restrictions places are limited and it is important that if your child wishes to attend that a place is booked in advance.

Children will not be able to 'turn up' as they did previously. The daily charge for Breakfast Club is £1.00 and as it is important to reduce the handling of cash, we ask that you please pay on a Monday for the whole week. We will confirm your child's place with you as soon as we can. Children attending breakfast club will be able to go straight in to the hall. **If you child is not attending Breakfast club, morning drop off times will change to 8:30am to 9am from 19th October 2020.**

Keeping Warm

Just a reminder that as the weather gets colder, children will need to wear layers in order to stay warm in our well-ventilated building. Your consent will be needed if you wish your child to have the Nasal Flu vaccination, and information about how to give or refuse your consent will be issued in due course.
