Our core text this term is Coraline. We will look at developing setting and character in descriptive narratives, as well as writing alternative endings to Coraline and developing playscripts based on the plot of the story. We will be working hard to consolidate our understanding of basic grammar and we will be applying new skills, like semi-colons, relative clauses and parenthesis, to extend our brilliant ideas!

Maths

The key focus for this half term is fractions. Children are learning:

- How to find equivalent fractions.
- Convert between mixed numbers and improper fractions.
- Add, subtract and multiply fractions.
- Compare and order fractions with different numerators and denominators.

Children will continue to practise basic skills covering the four basic operations.

Topic

Our History this half term is 'Crime and Punishment'. The children will explore law, crime and punishment from the Roman times to the present day. There will also be an opportunity to be a CSI for a day and unravel a murder mystery by collecting evidence and writing a report.
