English

In English we will be reading Rainbow Fish, Elmer and Rain Before Rainbows. We will be focusing on writing sentences using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We will learn to extend these sentences using adjectives.

Maths

In math's we will begin by looking at number and place value. We will start using number lines and number tracks to help us find one more than and one less than a given number. We will then move on to addition and subtraction, and finally we will explore the properties of shapes.

Topic

The topic this half term is 'Marvellous Me!'. We will learn about different types of houses and homes in the local area both past and present. This will incorporate a variety of geography and art-based activities.

Science

This half term, first, we are learning about animals. The children will consider the basic needs of animals for survival. Later, we'll look into how we can use our senses to find out about the world around us.
