### Key Information

### English

In English we are starting the term with a focus on the classic story of The Iron Man by Ted Hughes. The children will be re-writing an epic battle scene from the story between Iron Man and a Space Dragon!

After this, the children will be writing an entertaining informational text about the Stone Age, using their learning in History to make their writing exciting!

### Maths

In Maths, the children will start the term by exploring Number and Place Value of numbers up to 4-digits. This will help them understand how ones, tens, hundreds and thousands all link together and give them a strong understanding for the subsequent topics

Following this, we will look at Addition and Subtraction, followed by Geometry and Multiplication and Division.

### Topic

Our topic this term is Set in Stone with a focus on Stone Age Britain as it moved to the Iron Age. Our Art and DT lessons will tie in with the Stone Age theme.

In Geography we are learning about the countries and cities of the UK and in Computing we are learning about the internet

### Science

In our science topic is about rocks and the different types of rocks found around the world. This links to our Stone Age topic as we can investigate the type of rock used in the Stone Age such as flint and why these helped Stone Age People

### How you can help at home

- Listen to your child read at least three times a week.
- Encourage your child to practise their times tables.
- Encourage your child to complete their homework on SeeSaw.
- Help your child to practice their spellings.
