# Autumn Term 1 Shireen Class

### English

In English this term we begin with The Day Crayons Quit, the children will retell the story and focus on character descriptions. This is followed by the classic poem What is Pink? By Christina Rossetti. The children will use this as inspiration to write their own poem using the colours of the rainbow. We finish the term looking at instruction writing, linked closely with healthy eating. Throughout the weeks we are focusing on sentence structure, rhyming, use of adjectives and beginning to expand our sentences.

### Maths

This half term we will be looking at the place value of digits within 100. We will be using a variety of practical equipment to help consolidate our learning. This will be followed by addition and subtraction within 20. We finish the half term looking at the properties of shapes. Our times tables focus this half term is the 2 times tables. We shall introduce the children to times tables rock stars.

### Science

This half term we will be learning about animals, including humans. The children will consider the basic needs of animals for survival. They will learn about the importance of exercise and nutrition in more depth, including doing surveys of both the food they eat, and the favourite foods of their classmates. They will move on to think about how animals grow up from babies into adults and consider how their needs change.
