English

In English we will begin by looking at *The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark*, *Scaredy Squirrel* and will then be making our own poems around nocturnal animals. We are generally focusing on using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops while exploring different types of writing.

Maths

In Maths we will begin by looking at geometry before moving on to multiplication and division. Finally, we'll explore measurement before consolidating all knowledge taught.

Topic

The topic this half term is 'Twit Twoo', which will be incorporated in our English texts, and we'll be on the lookout for some woodland animals on our local walk!

Wider Curriculum

In Science we will be comparing animals, and in Geography we'll be exploring what the weather is like in the UK. We will finish off our half term by making windmills in DT!
