English

In English, we will firstly be looking at writing a diary, focusing on producing a sequence of sentences. Next, we will move on to non-fiction writes, including writing instructions.

Maths

In Maths, we will begin by looking at number and place value, before then learning about measurement and addition and subtraction. We will finish our Maths learning for the half-term with fractions.

Phonics

This half term we are continuing to learn lots of new sounds and tricky words – as many as one a day! Reading at home with your child is a brilliant way to make sure they are able to keep up with all the new learning.

Wider Curriculum
