ENGLISH

This half term, our English learning will continue with the Suffragette movement and exploring key figures who changed history. We will be focusing on Princess Sophia Duleep Singh and her remarkable contribution to the Suffragette movement where the children will then create a biography of her life. In addition, the children will be exploring the actions of the suffragettes and create a balanced argument of reasons for and against suffrage.

MATHS

In Maths we will be exploring ratio and looking at the relationship between ratio and fractions.

The children will learn and understand scale factors and how to draw to scale. In addition to this, the children will be introduced to algebra where they will learn how to form algebraic expressions using letters to represent numbers and unknown values.

TOPIC

Our continued topic this term is 'I have a Dream' where the children will explore inequalities and breaches of human rights through significant points in history. The children will understand how and why change has happened through movement and campaigns using art, debate, speech and explore the use of propaganda.

SCIENCE

In Science, the children will be learning about 'Energy, circuits, batteries and switches'. The children will draw conventional circuit diagrams, use models to explain current, resistance and voltage, compare batteries and their effects on bulb brightness, as well as applying their knowledge to design and create practical devices.
