Spring Term 1

Year 4 Rauf

English

In English this term, all texts will align with our new topic, 'Food Glorious Food'. We will be reading 'Quill Soup' by Alan Durant and writing our own versions of this trickster tale. We will then be studying the features of an explanation text and using our learning to write our own. We will be linking this with our science topic and writing an explanation text about how the digestive system works.

Topic

Our topic this half term is 'Where Does Food Come From? This is a Geography based topic and we will be exploring where in the world different food comes from and how it gets to us. We will be discussing air miles and their impact on the planet as well as looking at climate and why things grow in certain places. In DT, we will be making some of our own food on 'Biscuit Day'.

Science

In science, we will be learning about the digestive system and how it works including the types of teeth and their uses when eating our food.

Maths

In Maths, our times table focus this half term will be the 8x table. We will be revising place value knowledge before moving into our addition and subtraction unit- looking at different formal methods and problem solving. Our geometry unit is 'Position and \direction' where we will be looking at clockwise turns, anticlockwise turns and different angles.
