### English

We're focusing on Migration for this term's topic and will be writing diary entries, based on the book King of the Sky, some poems about childhood memories which stay with us for a long time and be writing about the Windrush generation through the books of Floella Benjamin and Benjamin Zephaniah. It will be a really interesting topic with lots of opportunity to place yourself in some one's shoes and think differently.

### Topic

In History we are looking at the Anglo-Saxon invasion of Britain. We'll consider the reasons for the Angle, Saxon and jute tribes coming to Britain and then how they lived and what we know about them from archaeological discoveries. In DT, we're going to be learning how to sew and be making decorative bookmarks around World Book Day.

### Science

Our science unit is titled States of Matter and we are investigating solids, liquids, gases, what causes materials to change between each state.

### Maths
